

Mediation Fee Schedule

(Effective September 1, 2021)

Two-Party Mediation

Full Day Mediation (8 hours): \$4,000/party

Half Day Mediation (4 hours): \$2,500/party

Multi-Party Mediation – Full Day (8 hours)

Three to Four Parties \$3,500/party

Five or More Parties \$2,500/party

Class Action Mediation – Full Day (8 hours)

Full Day Mediation (8 hours): \$10,000 total

If the parties agree to a fee-splitting arrangement other than equally among the parties, please advise our office. Our fee includes pre-mediation calls, review of all pre-mediation submissions, one mediation session of up to 8 hours (4 hours for half-day) and follow-up time up to one hour if the matter is not settled during the mediation session.

A “party” is defined as any individual, company or group of individuals or companies with a common interest and represented by one law firm.

A “class action mediation” refers to mediation of a class action, a putative class action, or a pre-litigation matter involving one or more named plaintiffs who purport to represent a group of similarly situated individuals who allegedly have common claims against a single party (as defined above).

If your case does not fall into one of the above groups, please contact our office to discuss special arrangements.

Cancellation Policy: Mediation is based on trust. In that spirit, our office does not charge a cancellation fee for mediations. We do ask that you provide as much notice as possible so we can attempt to fill the scheduled time with another matter. Typically, we will not be able to schedule another matter with less than a week’s notice. So please let us know as soon as you have decided the matter needs to be cancelled.

Whether or not you have worked with Michael Leb before, Michael encourages you to contact him to discuss his approach to mediation, the type of case on which you are working, or anything else you’d like to know as you make your decision about whom to select for the important role of mediating the dispute in which you are involved.
